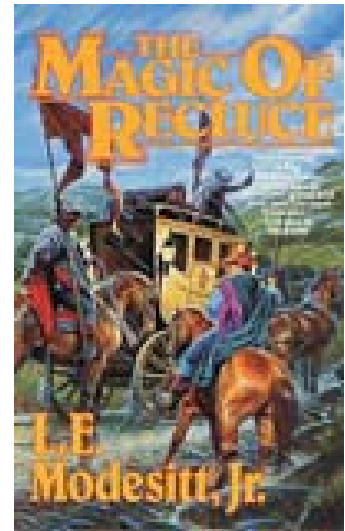
## L. E. Modesitt, Jr.

Mr. Modesitt has been a delivery boy; a lifeguard; an unpaid radio disc jockey; a U.S. Navy pilot; a market research analyst; a real estate agent; a director of research for a political campaign; legislative assistant and staff director for a U.S. Congressman; Director of Legislation and Congressional Relations for the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency; a consultant on environmental, regulatory, and communications issues; and a college lecturer and writer in residence. In addition to his novels, Mr. Modesitt has published technical studies and articles, columns, poetry, and a number of science fiction stories. His first story was published in 1973. He lives in Cedar City, Utah.

She was active in the field of antique carousel restoration from 1989 through 1999, painting suites of large scale paintings for the crestings of 5 antique carousels and decorative paintwork for a sixth.

# Programming Item - The Editors' Den

Keycon 28 will have several editors in attendance willing to consider manuscripts for publication. Space is limited and appointments will be required. You will have 15 minutes to make your pitch so come prepared.

Your submission package must include the following:

1) A professional query letter which includes the title of your novel, word count, genre, a brief biography and your contact information. Please list relevant publication credits.

2) A synopsis of your book that describes the story from beginning to end. Please keep it to 1-2 pages in length. Please give your synopsis an appropriate title, not simply 'synopsis'. i.e.:  
Synopsis-The Winner.

3) The First 50 pages or three chapters, in Times New Roman 12pt on white paper, print on one side only and indicate paragraph breaks with an indent. Please name your partial manuscript appropriately, i.e.:  
Partial-The Winner.

4) A promotional plan, showing short term and long term goals. While your submission won't be won or lost on the basis of this 'plan', it will get you thinking about what you can do to help promote your novel.

5) All pages need a header with the author's last name and manuscript title, i.e.: Smith/The Best Novel Ever
